**2: Rewards day, Years 7 – 10 Tuesday 19 July 2022**

**Year 11 leavers celebration: 10 June 2022 – school finishes for Years 7 – 10 at 12.30:**

School will finish early to allow Year 11 the time to celebrate and reflect on their life in school, 11 years is a long time. There will be food, the ice-cream van, activities and games, students will leave the site around 3.00pm.

There is a GCSE examination on the morning of 10 June and we need to recognise that this needs to run as smoothly as is possible and that the GCSEs continue on Monday 13 June 2022. Year 11 have to wear their uniform for their examinations, so please send in a spare shirt for the students to sign on Friday, so that we can have full, clean uniform for every subsequent examination and an orderly environment for the examinations. I realise that this may seem like a small point, but the beginning of an examination sets the tone for the examination itself and the smoother, and easier the start is, the less stress and pressure is added to students.

**Rewards day 19 July 2022**

We want the 19th to be another chance to thank the students for their behaviour and attitude towards each other, and school. We cannot afford to take the whole school away again, but I recognise that school runs far more smoothly as a result of the choices that the vast majority of your children make every day and I very much appreciate that. So, we are going to run a fun day this summer for the students who are in school. The bulk of Year 7 are away on a residential and Year 11 will have had their leavers day already, but I want the day to be target both as a thank you and an encouragement to those who need an incentive to help them make more positive choices. We are going to take Year 10 to Alton Towers, with the aim of doing this every year for the whole of Year 10. We will then aim to build a series of activities within and around school for the remainder of Year 7 and the whole of 8 and 9. There is a provisional outline below, but I have to say, that this is a privilege and not an entitlement, and just like the last rewards trip, students will only attend the activities if their attendance to school is good and their behaviour supports others within the community to be successful in school.

This is quite an undertaking and I would like to thank all of the staff for their help in setting all of these activities up, you for all your support this year and of course the students themselves, thank you.
