

# SPANISH Revision Timetable – 27<sup>th</sup> Feb 2020

The following is a **suggested** revision timetable. **Speaking tests will take place on 21<sup>st</sup> and 23<sup>rd</sup> April (with a final mock on 9<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> March). Listening and Reading exams are on 20<sup>th</sup> May and the Writing exam is on 3<sup>rd</sup> June.**

**Aim to do 3 x 45/60 mins Spanish revision sessions a week. Here are some suggestions for how to structure your revision.**

1. Use your revision guide and work on two or three sections a week – one section per revision session. Use Kerboodle for the topic you are working on and do one listening task and one reading task.
2. The headings in bold link to the AQA GCSE 1-9 Revision guide and workbook.
3. Vocabulary practice is important. Read the appropriate section in the guide and complete some of the exercises. Use your sentence builders and Quizlet as well.
4. Choose a selection of exercises from the workbook from the appropriate section to practise what you have revised. Mark them after completion using the marking guide.
5. Each week try to practise all four skills: listening, reading, writing and speaking.
6. Use your speaking note book and vocabulary book to work on speaking answers. Aim for spontaneity by practising key phrases but speaking aloud without using notes as far as possible. Have prompt sheets to support you as you gain in confidence.
7. Use section 11 on grammar every week as well. Read the topics suggested and do a couple of practice exercises. Use the AVOCADOS section on Quizlet to learn key verbs in different tenses. Practise using The Golden Rules in your speaking answers and when you write 90/150 word essays.
8. **TICK OFF WHAT YOU HAVE DONE ON THIS SHEET.** Make notes on things you need to return to. Use the blank weeks further on to note areas you would like to return to as well as leaving revision space for vocabulary learning and past papers.
9. Use the EDEXCEL/AQA websites as explained in class to access old exam papers, GCSE POD, BBC bitesize for further listening practice and QUIZLET/MEMRISE/DUOLINGO or GOJIMO apps for the exam specification studied for further revision. Listen to Spanish music on YouTube and watch Netflix in Spanish with English subtitles.
