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# All years

1. Have a routine and a plan for each day – use your school timetable to help you plan what you will work on.
2. Do some exercise, read a book and do something creative each day.
3. Spanish – use Duolingo – app on phone.
4. Watch programmes and films in Spanish with English sub-titles on Netflix.

6. Practise speaking – use your questions and speak out loud.
7. Record yourself speaking and replay it to yourself. Try to improve on fluency, pronunciation and pace.
