Dear Parents and carers

We have Merseyside Police coming in on Tuesday 15th October as part of a national cycle marking and registration scheme. It is used to help protect student's bikes from theft. Over 1.25 million bikes are registered and all UK Police Forces have immediate access to the database to carry out searches should they recover a lost or stolen bike.

Students are advised to bring their Bicycle to school on that day between 0815 and 0840 where officers will be on hand to mark the bicycle to help prevent loss and assist recovery.

As a reminder all students cycling to and from school should have a helmet and will need to consider having lights/high visibility as the clocks change for the winter.
