A big thank you to everyone who has already completed the **School Entry Health Questionnaire** via the secure link — your support helps us ensure every child gets the best start to school life.

The **School Entry Assessment (SEA)** is a routine health and wellbeing questionnaire offered to all children starting a new school stage (such as Year 7). It helps the **School Nursing Team** understand your child's health needs and provide the right support as they settle into school life.

The questionnaire asks about areas such as your child's growth, medical history, emotional wellbeing, and any additional support they might need. Your responses help us to:

- Identify any health issues that may affect your child's learning or development
- Offer advice, guidance, or early support where needed
- Plan health services across our schools more effectively

If you haven't had a chance to complete it yet, don't worry — we'll be resending the questionnaire in the coming weeks. Please note that the link will **expire seven days** after you receive it, so we encourage you to complete it as soon as possible.
